Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner-
Tanjeet Singh @ Dhanvir Singh in case FIR No.111 dated 24.06.2014, under
Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered
with Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Complainant Hardev Singh alleges that he was cheated a sum of
Rs. 12 lacs by the principal accused Rampal, a property dealer while getting an
agreement to sell executed for sale of a house measuring 100 square yards by
getting co-accused Sukhdev to impersonate the owner Manjit Singh alongwith
co-accused Sukhvinder Singh.

It was stated that name of the petitioner has surfaced only in the
enquiry conducted by the police as one of the conspirators while nothing has
come on record to substantiate that allegation.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has
joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by SI Jarnail Singh, agrees that the
petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no
longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by
this Court, vide order dated 02.05.2016, is made absolute.
