Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Jaswinder Kaur seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take immediate action against the accused persons as per law in FIR No. 15 dated 24.02.2016 registered at Police Station Bhakshi Wala, District Patiala.

It has been *inter-alia* submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though representation Annexure P-6 was moved to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representation within a stipulated period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation (Annexure P-6) and in case some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order
