The petitioner remained on interim bail during the period when the report of Forensic Science Laboratory was awaited. He has been found in possession of 160 gms of diphenoxylate hydrochloride salt which is a commercial quantity.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not misused his liberty and that he has been falsely implicated.

In view of the bar created by Section 37 of the NDPS Act, no ground is made out for grant of bail. Dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to approach this Court again after expiry of six months beyond the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court, in case the prosecution evidence is not concluded.
