Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 585, dated 24.06.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 186, 353, 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jhajjar.

As per allegations, on secret information, police party set up the check-post (*Naaka*) at Bye Pass Bridge, Jhajjar, and on their signal to stop, the petitioner alongwith his co-accused had tried to flee on their motorcycle. The petitioner is alleged to have fired shots repeatedly at the police party and also suffered a shot injury at the right knee, when fire was opened by the police in defence.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Kanhiya Lal that the petitioner is involved in at least eight other criminal cases.

In view of above, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
