JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 01.04.2016, registered under Sections 419, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station NRI Moga, District Moga.

Vide order dated 20.05.2016, the petitioner was admitted to interim bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is not cooperating. He refers to the sale deed wherein, the petitioner has made a categorical declaration before the Registrar that the signatories to the sale deed are known to him.

However, the documents pertaining to the parties are not found to be genuine.

Heard.

Though, the petitioner is only the attesting witness, but on the basis of his false declaration, the sale deed was executed. Despite availing repeated opportunities, the petitioner did not cooperate in the investigation. Therefore, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Dismissed.

However, nothing noticed hereinabove shall be construed as an expression of opinion of the Court on the merits of the case.
