Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioners, namely, Sukhpal Singh @ Filla, Iqbal Singh @ Nikka, Gurmail Singh @ Gela and Gurpreet Singh @ Kala in case FIR No.121 dated 31.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 324, 323, 341 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

At the very outset learned Counsel for the petitioners submit that the parties being co-villagers have effected an amicable settlement. Compromise is Annexure P-2. That apart he submits that the petitioners are in custody since 31.03.2016 and after completion of investigation challan

stands presented and even charge framed.

Learned Counsel for the complainant as well as learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Pritpal Singh do not dispute the fact of parties having arrived at an amicable settlement, the custody period and the stage of trial is also not disputed.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that parties have compromised the matter, present petition is allowed and the petitioners, namely, Sukhpal Singh @ Filla, Iqbal Singh @ Nikka, Gurmail Singh @ Gela and Gurpreet Singh @ Kala are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Petition stands disposed of.
