Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused in cross-version recorded as DDR No.25 dated 22.06.2015, under Sections 323, 325, 148, 149, IPC (**Annexure P-2**) and DDR No.06 dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 308, 328, 325, IPC (**Annexure P-3**) in case FIR No.64 dated 24.06.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC, registered with Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegation in the cross-version of the occurrence, on 18.06.2015 at around 12:00 PM, the petitioner is attributed single *Iron Rod* blow on the nose of the injured-Jagan Nath.

It is contended that the petitioner himself has received incised wound on the right arm forming part of the version recorded as FIR No.64 dated 24.06.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 34, IPC. That apart, it is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 27.10.2015 and after completion of the investigation, challan in the cross-version has been filed.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jaswinder Singh, neither refute the custody period nor the fact that the challan having been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
