Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the official respondents to give police protection to the petitioners from respondents No.5 and 6 and further directing respondents No.1 to 4 not to register any criminal case against the petitioners.

No one present on behalf of the petitioners as an adjournment slip has been filed. Even on last date of hearing also, no one was present on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel while referring to reply filed by way of affidavit of Joginder Singh, DSP (AEC) Kaithal submits that the present petition is frivolous one as FIR No.31, dated 28.03.2015, under Section 307 IPC and 25, 29, 30 of Arms Act has been registered at Police Station Dandh, District Kaithal, against petitioner No.4. Petitioner No.4 is the son of

petitioners No.1 and 2 and petitioner No.3 is the wife of petitioner No.4.

Taking into consideration the fact that FIR No.31, dated 28.03.2015, under Section 307 IPC and 25, 29, 30 of Arms Act has been registered at Police Station Dandh, District Kaithal, against petitioner No.4 which fact has not been disclosed by the petitioner in the petition, the present petition is liable to be dismissed on the ground of concealment of that fact.
