Petitioner in the capacity as a professional Advocate has issued reports on the basis of which NOCs regarding non-existent properties were submitted as a result of which loss was caused to the bank and others.

Counsel appearing on the behalf of the HDFC Bank has intervened to oppose the application contending that the petitioner in the present case and other case has played fraud with the bank and caused huge loss.

In view of the fact that co-accused of the petitioner have been granted concession of bail and the extent of culpability of the petitioner is to be determined during the course of trial which is likely to take a long time, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
