The petitioner has approached this Court for a direction for fair investigation contending that certain important documents indicative of the innocence of the petitioner have been ignored. Challan has already been presented against the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the observations of this Court in order dated 2.5.2016, after filing of this petition, a representation has already been made to the DGP, Punjab on 23.6.2016. A photocopy of the representation has been placed on record.

Since the petitioner has already availed one of the alternative remedies available to him, I do not deem it appropriate to exercise inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuing any direction.

This petition is disposed of, at this stage, expecting that the grievance of the petitioner would be looked into by the competent authority in accordance with law within a reasonable time.
