The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 19.09.2015 in a case of recovery of 106 bottles of rexcof and 1830 tablets of Codiene Phosphate (which tablets do not constitute an offence under the NDPS Act) from Deepak @ Deepa and Binder Singh who were apprehended by the police while coming on motorcycle. The petitioner was involved in the case on the basis of disclosure statement that the petitioner had supplied the contraband for a sum of Rs.13,000/.

It has been informed that the petitioner is involved in few more cases of similar nature of having supplied intoxicant substances.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail only subject to the condition that the moment he indulges in similar activities again, the bail will be liable to be cancelled on the asking of the prosecution agency.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the

trial Court. The petitioner will be required to furnish an affidavit at the time of his release before the trial Court undertaking that his bail will be liable to be cancelled in case he again indulges in similar activities, during the entire period of the trial.
