By virtue of the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. petitioner has sought issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 to 4 to protect her life and liberty.

Notice was issued and reply filed by the State earlier. As per representation dated 03.12.2015, FIR was registered that the instant case was not found to be occurred, so, FIR which was earlier registered had been cancelled. Now the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that another representation (Annexure P-4) was moved on 9th April, 2016 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran but till date no action has been taken despite the fact that petitioner was found in illegal detention by the Warrant Officer.

The instant petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in her representation dated 9th April, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
