JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of Complaint No. 150-2 of 2007, dated 15.12.2007 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 of IPC and order dated January 06, 2015, passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-2), along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated December 10, 2015, report

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of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise without any coercion, threat or undue influence from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law as compromise is for their benefit and would bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and Complaint No. 150-2 of 2007, dated 15.12.2007 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 of IPC and order dated January 06, 2015, passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-2) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
