Rajan Gupta, J (Oral)

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all his pleas before the trial court at an appropriate stage. He further submits that personal appearance of the petitioner may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case, petitioner moves an application for exemption of his personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioner on such terms and conditions as it deems proper to impose. Petitioner may be allowed to appear through his counsel except on the dates when his presence is necessary.
