This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.149 dated 12.09.2014 registered under Section 346 IPC (offence under Sections 363/366-A/376 IPC has been added later on) and under Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual offence Act, 2012 and under Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa and subsequent proceedings including framing of charge and also for quashing of order dated 11.02.2016, whereby, the Additional Sessions Judge, Sirsa has summoned the remaining prosecution witnesses under Section 311 Cr.P.C.

Admittedly, the petitioner had earlier filed **Criminal Misc. No.M-23119 of 2015**, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 10.09.2015 to

enable him to raise all the pleas before the trial Court at appropriate stage.

The petitioner, in stead of availing the appropriate remedy, has filed the present petition for quashing of FIR as well as other proceedings arising therefrom.

No ground is made out to interfere at this stage.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved by Order dated 11.02.2016, he can challenge the same separately.
