FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 01.07.2016 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Batala has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Gopal Dass, victim/witness Ketan and the accused persons namely Hardeep Singh, Jagroop Singh, Jugraj Singh, Dil @ Dilpreet Singh and Satta @ Satnaam Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure money dispute, the fact that the offences for which the accused

have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.7 dated 25.01.2016 registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur under Sections 365/342/506 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
