Report dated 22.07.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Ajay Sood, Asha Rani, Varinder Mohan Sood, Vipin Sood as well as of complainant Surinder Mohan Sood it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3)**

RCR Criminal 1052, DDR No.5 dated 17.01.2013 under Section 66 of the Police Act, Police Station, Daresi, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
