The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.92 dated 01.07.2012 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506 & 509 IPC and Sections 66/67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, in view of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Pursuant to order dated 29.09.2016 the petitioner has filed the affidavit, which is taken on record and marked as X for perusal of the record. Copy thereof is supplied to counsel for the complainant. The order dated 29.09.2016 reads thus:

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
file affidavit of the petitioner that:*

(i) *The petitioner will tender apology to the girl and her family as well.*

(ii) *He would never indulge in harassing the girl again. In case any such complaint is received the petitioner would be ready to face trial in the present case upon reopening.*

Adjourned to 18.10.2016.”

Now there is proposal for compromise/compounding. In my opinion, the petitioner should be given a chance for improvement since he has now undertaken by way of affidavit that he would not trouble the girl or any member of her family, in the interest of justice. In order to give one chance to the petitioner, FIR No.92 dated 01.07.2012 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506 & 509 IPC and Sections 66/67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, is quashed by way of compromise/compounding along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
