Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair enquiry in the complaint submitted by the petitioner.

Prayer has also been made for issuing directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to register a case against respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, contends that the petitioner does not press his prayer to register a case against the respondent No.4 and the present petition be dismissed to that extent. Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 7.1.2016 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, but no action thereon has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
