JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Tejkaran Singh-petitioner seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents-State only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that

though various representations were moved including representation dated 11.04.2016 (Annexure P-11) but till date no substantive action has been taken.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 11.04.2016 (Annexure P-11) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
