JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Balwinder Kaur seeking proper investigation in a complaint filed by her to respondent No.3 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that a complaint dated June 11, 2015 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to dispose of the complaint (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

3. Notice to official respondents only, at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her complaint (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
