This petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.229 dated 13.11.2015, registered under Sections 120-B, 307, 324, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

It is contended that similarly situated co-accused Gurpreet Singh and Harpinder Singh, have already been admitted to regular bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. He further states that two injuries have been attributed to the petitioner, out of which one being simple in nature and other one is on the non vital part.

The petitioner is in custody since 02.12.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application and submits that though the injury attributed to the petitioner is on non vital part but the same was grievous in nature.

Heard.

Considering the fact that as many as 25 injuries were given to the victim out of which 20 were incised wounds, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail.

Dismissed.
