Prayer in the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Gobind Singh is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 36, dated 23.04.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85, Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

As per allegations, there is alleged recovery of 100 tablets of Microlit from the polythene bag carried by the accused/petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been acquitted by the trial Court, and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
