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**JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana to

look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated April 30, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
