Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.317 dated 25.11.2014, under Sections 21/22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

As per prosecution version an alleged recovery of 200 grams of intoxicant powder was effected from the petitioner.

It has gone uncontroverted that as per report of Chemical Examiner, powder was found containing Tramado Hydrochloride.

State counsel would submit that as per report of Chemical Examiner, though no case under NDPS Act is made out, however, the present petition is opposed on the ground that petitioner is involved in 03 other cases under NDPS Act.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner would clarify that in each of such 3 cases, the petitioner is on bail.

It may also be noticed that the petitioner was arrested on

03.12.2014 and since Chemical Examiner's Report was awaited, this Court, on 06.05.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is not stated to have misused the concession.

In view of the above, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail. Order dated 06.05.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
