Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.139 dated 21.6.2014, registered under Sections 279, 427 IPC, at Police Station Phase-I, District Mohali, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Mohali received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused and has reported that the parties have effected compromise which is voluntary with their free will and consent, without any fear or pressure. Statements of the parties have also been enclosed with the report.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.139 dated 21.6.2014, registered under Sections 279, 427 IPC, at Police Station Phase-I, District Mohali, along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
