JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Ramnik Singh seeking quashing of FIR No. 158 dated October 11, 2015 under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 427 IPC registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he does not press for the relief of quashing of FIR in question at this stage. However, he submits that a representation dated January 05, 2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.2) for proper investigation in the afore-said FIR alleging that he has been falsely implicated in the afore-said case. He feels satisfied in case a

direction is issued to respondent No.2 to enquire into the matter and deal with his representation (Annexure P-2).

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing anything on the merit of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police-respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
