Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.40 dated 29.03.2016, registered at Police Station Women, Ludhiana City, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 406, 498-A, 377, 354, 341, 506 and 120-B IPC.

In compliance with the order dated 11.08.2016 passed by this Court, the parties were relegated to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per report dated 29.08.2016, the matter has been compromised between the parties. As per agreement, ₹95,00,000/- is given to the complainant as full & final settlement. It was also agreed that on 31.08.2016 by way of demand draft a sum of ₹10,00,000/- shall be paid by

the petitioner. The demand draft for the said amount has been handed over

to the complainant, who is present in the Court today.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 05.05.2016 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
