On 04.05.2016, the following order was passed:

Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Sukhchain Singh of Italy alleging that his father's land was illegally possessed by the petitioner and others in his absence.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab, for June 1, 2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on May 14, 2016 and in case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

On 27.09.2016, the following order was passed:

In the morning on first call Ms.

Sunita Nambia, Advocate had appeared and stated that the petitioner was ready to hand over the possession of the land in dispute to the complainant. When the Court asked her how much time the petitioner would require to do the needful she sought pass over. Now on second call nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. It is almost now 5 P.M. In the interest of justice, the matter is adjourned to 29.09.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite best efforts, the petitioner has not given any instructions.

In the circumstances, it is clear that the petitioner had made a false statement in the court because on 17.09.2016 the matter was adjourned on the statement that the petitioner was ready to hand over the possession of the land in dispute to the complainant.

Consequently, interim order is vacated and the petition stands dismissed.
