Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct investigation in case FIR No.150 dated 14.3.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Palwal (Annexure P-1) by a senior rank officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in order to seek fair investigation, he has already moved a representation dated 19.4.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Anil Kumar Chahal, Deputy A.G., Haryana. accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the case file.

The FIR in question was registered on 14.3.2016 and, therefore, it is too early to interfere in the investigation. However, without commenting upon the contents of the representation (Annexure P-2), respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Palwal, is directed to get note of the representation and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
