Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for calling a status report in FIR No.43 dated 31.03.2013 under Section 302/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that more than three years have passed, but the police has not completed the investigation so far.

Learned counsel for the State has filed status report on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, by way of affidavit of Shubeg Singh, PPS, Deputy Supdt. of Police, Sub-Division Fazilka, along with Annexure R-1 (copy of analysis report) and Annexure R-2(copy of doctor's report). The same is taken on record.

Status report suggests that the FIR in question was registered against four accused namely Joginder Singh alias Ginda, Surjeet Singh,

Lakhi alias Vijay Kumar and Amin Chand on the statement of the petitioner/complainant. The allegations against the accused were that the accused murdered Surjan Singh(uncle/chacha of the petitioner). Investigation in the case has been conducted and it has been found that deceased Surjan Singh died due to consuming excess alcohol and other substance and this fact was corroborated by the affidavit and statement of the petitioner/complainant made before the police.

Report further suggest that the police has prepared the cancellation report in the abovesaid FIR on 09.04.2014 and the same was also submitted before the learned Court on 27.08.2014. Now, the case is fixed before the learned Magistrate on 01.09.2016 for consideration.

In view of the status report so filed particularly when police has prepared the cancellation report and submitted the same before the learned Magistrate, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, petitioner is at liberty to file the objection/protest petition in case he is not satisfied with the cancellation report so submitted.
