No useful purpose will be served after over two decades to enter upon seniority dispute resolution amongst parties who have retired long ago.

The claim in the petition was by a member of the Scheduled Caste claiming promotion on the basis of the first roster point vacancy in a cadre of less than 5 for promotion to the posts of District Attorney as also Joint Director Prosecution & Litigation. The matter is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as such. However with liberty to the parties to approach the Court, in case, they have any residual grievance left to be adjudicated.
