Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to transfer the investigation of the complaint of the petitioner to police authorities outside the District or to some independent agency such as CBI or CID or to constitute SIT.

3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case representation dated October 06, 2015 (Annexure P-4) moved by petitioner is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated October 06, 2015 (Annexure P-4) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
