AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.52 dated 24.03.2016, registered under Sections 148/149/285/427/452/506 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

It is stated that pursuant to the order dated 04.05.2016 the petitioners have appeared and have been granted interim bail by the trial Court.

Learned Additional Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Ram Kumar has accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 04.05.2016 is made absolute. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
