**JASPAL SINGH, J.**

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.144, dated 12.12.2014, under Sections 148/149 IPC (*deleted*), 323/341 IPC (*offence under Section 341 deleted*) 342 IPC (*added later on*) 354-B, 506, 307 and 34 IPC (*added later on*) Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) and FIR No. 137, dated 02.12.2014, under Sections 323, 506, 34, 148, 149, 308, 325, 354-B IPC (*added later on*) along with all subsequent proceedings arising out of both these FIRs, on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received,

in which, it has been categorically observed that statements of both the parties were recorded after ascertaining that the same has been recorded without any undue pressure, undue influence or coercion. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of above circumstances and in view of the authorities reported as **Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another ; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543 and Kulwinder Singh & others v. State of Punjab & others; 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.144, dated 12.12.2014, under Sections 323, 342, 354-B, 506, 307 and 34 IPC as well as FIR No. 137, dated 02.12.2014, under Sections 323, 506, 34, 148, 149, 308, 325, 354-B IPC, Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad alongwith all other consequential proceedings arising out of both the above said FIRs are quashed qua the petitioners.
