Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation against respondents No. 4 to 12 in case FIR No.208 dated 05.11.2012, for offence under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 506/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, Distt. SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head constable-Ashok Kumar submits that in the case in hand, the police has earlier submitted a cancellation report in the Court of SDJM, Dera Bassi, however, the same was not accepted and the learned Magistrate has sent back the case for further investigation.

In view of the above, since the matter has been referred for further investigation, no effective order is required to be passed in the present case.

However, it is directed that the further investigation shall be conducted under the supervision of SSP, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
