ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL):

Concededly, in the appeals preferred by the landowners arising out of the same acquisition, this Court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners, vide judgement dated 02.08.2014, rendered by this Court in RFA No.681 of 1994, titled “Balbir Singh son of Nazar Singh versus Union of India and another”.

So much so, the appeals preferred by the Union of India, against the same award were dismissed for non prosecution and learned counsel for the appellant fairly submits that the necessary applications for their restoration were never moved. In any case, once this Court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners, this appeal, as a necessary consequence, shall have to be dismissed.
