FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 19.05.2016 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phul has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant-Jaspal Kaur, Injured-Bant Singh and Sukhdeep Singh and the accused persons namely Jaspal Singh, Harpal Singh, Jaspreet Singh, Gursewak Singh and Sukhvir Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the offences for which the accused persons have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in

ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in "**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**" 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**" 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.50 dated 29.07.2012 registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the present petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
