By filing this petition, under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.94 dated 14.10.2015 registered under Sections 20 & 31 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar S.B.S. Nagar, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 75 years of age. He further states that the petitioner is suffering from various age related diseases. Allegedly, 1 kg of charas which is non commercial quantity, was recovered from her. She is in custody since 14.10.2015.

Learned State counsel informs that two other cases of similar nature are pending against the petitioner. In one of the cases, 3 kgs of poppy husk and in other case 5 kgs of poppy husk was recovered from the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the quantity of the poppy husk recovered from the petitioner was non-commercial and the petitioner is aged about 75 years and the charges have yet not been framed, therefore, it can safely be

inferred that the conclusion of trail will take a long time, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
