Report dated 24.05.2016 sent by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Mandeep Singh, Gurpreet Singh and Thomas as well as of complainant Narinder Singh Sethi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down
