Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rajbir Singh in case FIR No.726 dated 17.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City Yamuna Nagar.

Allegations of complainant Parveen Chachra are that petitioner accused cheated him for a sum of Rs.14.5 lacs by selling a land based on forged documents. It is contended that the parties have effected a compromise (P-2) and the same is acknowledged by affidavit (P-3) of the complainant. Even a petition for quashing of the FIR based on compromise has been filed and is listed for 18.7.2016.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submit that pursuant to the

interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Subash Chand does not dispute the joining of the petitioner in the investigation pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner and also filing of petition for quashing by the petitioner based on compromise. In the face of the compromise, he submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner would no longer be required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 05th of May, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
