This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.77 dated 29.10.2015 registered under Sections 392/427 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Kotfatta, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have been in custody since 01.11.2015 and the trial is not proceeding.

Learned Additional Advocate General states that the whole case hinges on the testimony of the complainant-Manoj Parkash who has now stated to appear to give his testimony on 03.10.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the complainant-Manoj Parkash intentionally has not been turning up to give his evidence.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed. However, it is directed that in case complainant-Manoj Parkash does not turn up to give his testimony on 03.10.2016 they be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
