Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated September 11, 2015 (Annexure P-2) in respect of FIR No. 191, dated 18.12.2014, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and further for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 11.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied and does not claim any relief in respect of the other prayers made in this petition, in case, representation (Annexure P-2) is dealt with disposed of by the concerned authorities.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that though representation (Annexure P-2) was moved by the petitioner way-back on September 11, 2015 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.2 but till date no substantive action has been taken.

6. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated September 11, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
