Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.22 dated 16.3.2016, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

This Court vide order dated 5.5.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter vide order dated 25.7.2016 petitioner was again directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to orders dated 5.5.2016 and 25.7.2016, the petitioner has joined the

investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Harnek Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 5.5.2016 and 25.7.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
