Instant petition has been preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") by Jagdish Singh, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case FIR No.104, dated 08.02.2016, under Section 306 IPC, Police Station City Hisar.

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion vide order dated 05.05.2016, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Sunil, complainant alleging that his father Mohinder had committed suicide as petitioner has got transferred some property in his name without paying the sale consideration to the deceased.

Petitioner claims that as a matter of fact he had given a loan to the deceased but on account of he having failed to repay and to evade liability, petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab, for July 13, 2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on May 14, 2016 and in case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

3. Learned State counsel, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana has very fairly submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 13.05.2016 and further his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts of the case, interim order dated 05.05.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
