Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No. 3 to 5 to comply with the provisions of Section 160 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Section 41 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State has filed the reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5, by way of affidavit of Mukhtiar Rai, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahar Sub Division, Distt. Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, along with Annexure R-1/T i.e. English translation of disclosure statement. The same are taken on record.

On the basis of the reply, learned counsel for the State submits though there is no case against petitioner Nos. 1 and 2, however, there are number of cases registered against petitioner No.3-Nimma son of Meet Ram.
