Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. In FIR No.933 dated 27.11.2015, under Sections 186, 332, 353, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, the petitioner is being prosecuted. The petitioner is a police officer against whom the allegation is that he was running a gambling den.

Without going into the truthfulness about the allegations, I find that the offences are such the petitioner can be granted the relief of anticipatory bail.

This Court had made an interim order dated 5.5.2016 granting the relief of anticipatory bail the said order is therefore made absolute.

Counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has been put under suspension and departmental inquiry has been ordered against him.
