This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Allegation in the FIR is that accused entered into the shop of the complainant after breaking the lock at 1.00 A.M. As people raised hue and cry, they fled from the spot.

According to counsel for the petitioners, investigation has been completed and trial is in progress. He further submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial court at appropriate stage.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
