Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of accused persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has approached respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City by way of representation dated 15.3.2016 (Annexure P-3), but no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of claim/representation of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
