The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.135 dated 18.06.2015, under Section 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 260 grams of intoxicant powder.

Samples having been sent, report of the Chemical Examiner has been received which shows the presence of salt Alprazolam.

Quantity of such salt in excess of 100 grams would be construed as commercial quantity.

In the light of such commercial quantity allegedly recovered from the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to entertain a prayer for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
